Summary of Responsibilities

The Housekeeper performs any combination of duties to maintain a high quality of cleanliness in all guest rooms, meeting areas, lobbies, and offices at Carol Joy Holling Center. The housekeeper ensures that all interior spaces are in a clean and orderly manner. Duties include making beds, replenishing linens, cleaning rooms, offices and halls, and vacuuming.

Position Responsibilities

Maintain a tidy, safe and welcoming environment for all guests by:

- 1. Cleaning cabins, rooms, meeting spaces, hallways, lobbies, lounges, restrooms, showers, corridors, elevators, stairways, offices, and other lodging and work areas so that health standards are met.
- 2. Carry linens, towels, toilet items, and cleaning supplies, using wheeled carts.
- 3. Vacuum carpets and mop floors.
- 4. Empty wastebaskets and transport other trash and waste to disposal areas.
- 5. Replenish supplies, such as drinking glasses, linens, writing supplies, and bathroom items.
- 6. Disinfect equipment and supplies, using germicides or other approved sterilizers.
- 7. Observe precautions required to protect NLOM and guest property and report damage, theft, and found articles to supervisor.
- 8. Keep storage areas and carts well-stocked, clean, and tidy.
- 9. Dust and polish furniture and equipment.

- 3. Thorough understanding of NLOM's policies and practices.
